Power (De-type) Seminar

The power seminar has its logical basis in the discovery by Alfred Korzybski, father of General Semantics, that the Aristotelian system of Cause and Effect is **unsane**; this was a finding corroborated by Richard Bandler and John Grinder, founders of Neuro-Linguistic Programming who described it as **semantically ill-formed**.

How the system weaves its insanity in the life of anyone using the philosophy of Cause and Effect is by its **language structures**. A language structure is not the same as the actual words spoken by a person. The language structure of a linguistic system is the underpinning that the person uses to drive his thinking and out it the words he will speak. Let us cite an example. You hear a person shout this at another:

Dam it. Can't you ever be on time?

The linguistic structure for this sentence is **SHOULD** as in the rule of the person's life:

People **SHOULD** be on time!

An alternative linguistic structure would be **MUST** as in this rule of the person's life:

People **MUST** be on time!

It was Alfred Korzybski's discovery that it was the Non-Aristotelian system that was the basis for sane human thinking and being. With this, he tried to discover what its language structures were. In this he was to acknowledge that he failed in his work, *Science and Sanity*; but in it wrote the wish that one day a student of his would do so.

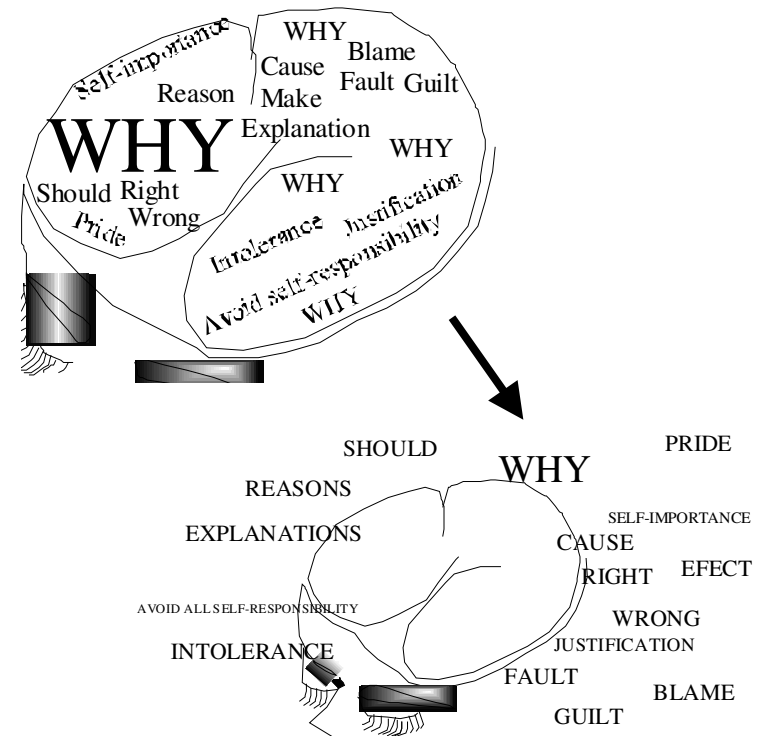
This was done for him 43 years later in the work *Power and Elegance in Communication* that was published in 1993.

Given the elucidation of the language structures of the Aristotelian and Non-Aristotelian systems, it was very

clear to the Trainers that all they had to do was to teach the student the Non-Aristotelian language system.

If the student acquired an automatic and intuitive facility over it, he/she would override all the linguistic structures of the Aristotelian system, a.k.a. Blame Frame from their minds. And if this happened, it would open their minds to the vistas of new and incredible alternatives.
