Guide to the Light in You

From their research Dennis and Jennifer Chong realized that healing has to do with a change in people's way of being and the power that is within them.

everything into a coherent model, they found certain of the components by themselves were able to reverse a cancer. They estimate that they in fact inverted the cancers of some 9 patients. When they were satisfied that the component elements worked, they had to determine if the model, as a whole, would work. They had a willing cancer patient to find out if it would work; and the result was a success.
